



School Lunch Information Sheet

One of the many ways individuals and groups can support Jubilee Academy is by providing school lunches. Volunteers can sign up to provide lunches on a weekly or monthly recurring basis, or can simply sign up for any open day on the lunch calendar. We have lots of school days to fill!

What we need

We request that you provide 25 servings, to arrive at the school by 11:30 am. There are two ways you can do this.

1. Bring lunch at 11:30 and stay to eat with us! We love to have people join us!
2. Bring lunch ahead of time with instructions for storing, heating and serving.

Jubilee will provide plates, napkins and utensils. The school kitchen has a refrigerator, a microwave, a small countertop convection oven and a large crockpot. If you would like to bring lunch ahead of time, please keep in mind that we are limited in the ways we can heat foods. We recommend things that can be warmed in the crockpot during the morning. For casseroles, we've also found that the Hefty EZ-Foil 6lb roasting pans work perfectly for our convection oven.

We do have one student with a pork allergy, but there are no other known food allergies.

What we like

The students at Jubilee are generally not picky eaters, but here are a few suggestions of things that they will enjoy. We appreciate healthy choices!

- Ham or turkey sandwiches, chips and fruit
- Macaroni and cheese (two large casseroles are good), grapes, veggies and dip
 - Spaghetti, bread and salad
 - Soup and corn muffins
- Chicken tenders, applesauce and vegetables
 - Tacos or burritos and fruit
- Warm casseroles (two large casseroles are good) and salad
